CONVENTION UPDATES!!! COVID-19 IMPACT

State Convention - The State Sponsor and State Association Leadership is in touch with the Convention Hotel and is aware of current State government guidelines. Depending on the date of the session it may be too early to make the call, but the decision about holding the State Convention will be made as soon as circumstances allow. Until you hear otherwise, it is on.

National Convention - The Convention Committee is well-aware of the situation and in touch with the Maryland Convention hotels and officials. Maryland State guidelines may make the decision for us (their restaurants and bars are currently closed). It is much too early to decide, but if a decision is made to cancel, that decision will be made in early to mid-June, if not sooner. Otherwise, again, until you hear otherwise, it is on.

AN UPDATE FROM OUR STATE MEETING HELD ON MARCH 22, 2020 (submitted by Robert Schneider)

Attention all NH Lodges – This was proposed, voted on and approved today at the NHSEA Meeting, held at the Franklin, NH Elks Lodge #1280.

In an effort to help relieve the financial impact that the COVID - 19 virus is likely to have on our lodges in NH, a motion was made and approved by the members in attendance as follows:

The NH State Elks Association will reimburse all lodges for their State Association Per Capita dues, paid by by May 1, 2020, for the 2020 - 2021 fraternal year, to be allocated to each lodge's General Fund.

In addition, under Good of the Association:

The State Trustees elected to waive the application process for the State Association grant of \$150.00. Each lodge will receive this grant for the 2020 - 2021 fraternal year.

The NH State Elks Association and State Trustees hope these two measures will help our lodges get through these trying times. If you have questions or concerns about this, please contact me at your earliest convenience.
