Steak Tips for "dinner" which will include corn on the cob and pasta salad starting at 5:00 PM

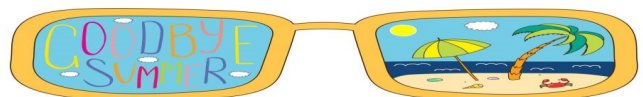
DJ Robyn will be in the "house" 7:00 PM to 11:00 PM
