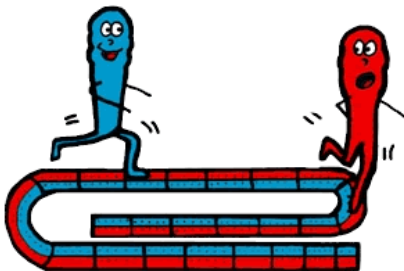
AL & Marion Savage were inducted into the Holman Stadium Hall of Fame Sunday August 9th 2020.

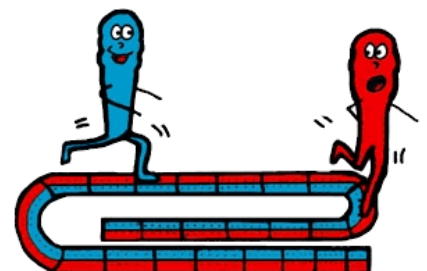
