Covid 19 will be a memory so please come down to the Lodge and enjoy!

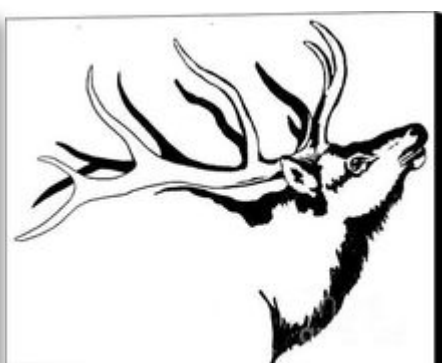
The event is free for qualifying Old Timers Members and their (one) guest.
